

## Headstart to National 5 Biology



Our Headstart Courses are designed to prepare students for their upcoming year of learning, by teaching them 30-40% of the course over summer. Students are then provided with an athome test at the end of the course, to consolidate the material covered. After which tutors will provide further guidance to get them in the best position possible for the new school year. Headstart courses are offered for Biology, Chemistry, English, Maths and Physics.

**Measure Progress** - After the 20 hours of teaching, students will have an additional hour of tutoring to go through an at-home assessment that they are set at the end of the course.

Achievable Goals - with only 4 hours of teaching per week, students have plenty of time off and will feel less pressured going into the coming year of studies.

Be Prepared - Course notes, worksheets and practice papers are all provided.

## **Course Content**

- Cell Structure and Transport (3-4 hours)
- Producing New Cells (2-3 hours)
- DNA and Protein Production (3-4 hours)
- Proteins and Enzymes (2-3 hours)
- Genetic Engineering (2-3 hours)
- Photosynthesis and Respiration (3-4 hours)
- Revision (1-2 hours)
- Discussion of at-home assessment (1 hour)
- Ongoing practise of essential numeracy skills.
- Additional topics can be added if the student has already covered and fully understands any of the above topics.

Full cost of course is £520, £60 of which due as a nonrefundable deposit to secure a place. With the remaining £460 due after the first 2 hour lesson. £20 discount per referral.

## **Course Timeline**



- 20 hours of teaching + 1 hour final lesson for discussion of assessment.
- 2x2 hour lessons per week (10-15min break between hours if required).
- Delivered over 5-week period (breaks for holidays can be arranged).
